Fixed Penalty Notices (FPN)

Cardiff Council's Policy is that persistent absence and lateness may lead to a FPN.

Persistent absence is attendance below 90%

Here are some of the reasons why a FPN may be requested and issued:

- 10, or more, unauthorised absences (5 school days) in the current term and these do not need to be consecutive;
- Children arrive after 9.30am for more than 10 sessions in the current term.
- Parents/carers don't engage with the school and/or the SAO in attempts to improve attendance.
- ❖ An unauthorised holiday is taken.

We don't want to request these.

We want to work with you to improve your child's attendance.
