Punctuality

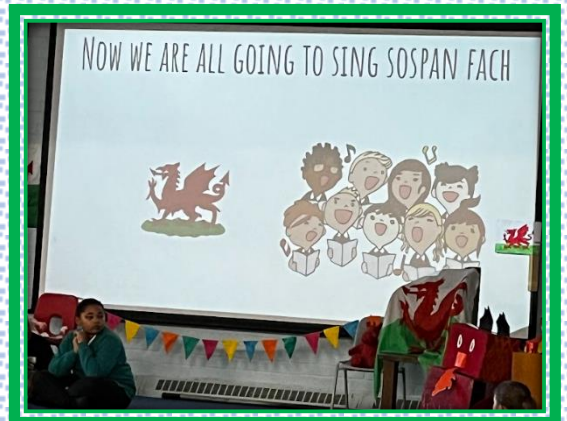
Remember, school starts at 8.55am. Children should be in class and learning at this time.
